

Here are some examples of **FOG** that you should never put down the drain.

### **FATS**

- Cheeses
- Ice Cream
- Butter
- Meat Trimmings

### **OILS**

- Salad Dressings
- Cooking Oil
- Vegetable Oil
- Canola Oil
- Olive Oil
- Corn Oil

### **GREASE**

- Gravy
- Bacon/Sausage
- Mayonnaise



## **How to dispose of FOG properly**

- Scrape all pans into garbage. Then **Dry Wipe** pan with paper towel and dispose of in garbage.
- Pour liquid oil or grease into solid container (ex: glass jar, metal coffee can etc.) and allow to cool and solidify. Then toss in garbage.
- Contact your local government to see if they have a cooking oil recycling program.

## **WIPES**

A new major factor, that has been contributing to SSOs, has been **Flushable Wipes**. These wipes do not break down like normal tissue paper does. As a result, these wipes get stuck in the sewer pipes and the pumps that move the wastewater. If you use these wipes, please **dispose of them in the garbage not the toilet.**
